

The two best options for motels are the Guest Lodge in Pageland, SC (14 miles north east) and the Quality Inn in Lancaster, SC (24 miles west). Below are photos of the Guest Lodge and also the Quality Inn.

The best accommodation in the area is Kilburnie, the Inn at Craig Farm. It is a bed and breakfast located near Lancaster. It is also 24 miles from the field. There is a separate photo and link to their website. Highly recommended.
