

Pet Policies

Dogs are free to roam on the dirt road, but not on the airfield.

Below is a picture of Thermal Trail, the dog walking road! Dogs may run as they wish on this road, at their own risk, of course. It is a dirt road with little traffic. It is close to a mile to the end of the road. It is wonderful for walking and running. Please walk your dogs to the north of the field down this dirt road. Walk through the opening at the big hangar. In this way you will avoid walking by the cabin compound.



This road is a great place to walk because they won't be able to leave their business on the field for others to discover. There are no trailer tires to mark, no sailplane wings to walk on, no neighborhood dogs to upset, however there are a lot of trees for marking and leaving dog messages! There are squirrels to chase! There are Black vultures to disturb in the old cotton gin barn. Deer tracks to investigate. Turkey tracks to follow and quail to flush. Cows live at the end of the road. Perhaps it's best not to chase our neighbor's cows.

Several dogs live on the field and have their own territory. Dogs, other than Min, are not allowed inside the clubhouse. Only “Min”, the English Mastiff resides inside.

Please keep your favorite pet on a leash and pick up after your dog.
We have plenty of plastic bags should you need some!
